Residents Survey Response Summary – Protecting the future of our community facilities survey.

This document provides a summary of the London Colney Neighbourhood Plan consultations undertaken between 1st March 2022 – 7th April 2022. The findings of the survey identify existing community facilities that residents would like to be protected from loss in the London Colney Neighbourhood Plan.

1. Background

Policy SF2: Community Facilities will look to list important community facilities that should be protected from loss. The aim of this consultation was to identify these facilities.

The consultation which was open from 1st March 2022 – 7th April 2022 was advertised via Facebook community group for the neighbourhood plan, the Parish council Facebook page, local groups on social media, the mailing list for the neighbourhood plan was sent a link to the survey, the survey was also advertised on the dedicated website for the plan – www.londoncolneyneighbourhoodplan.org and the Parish council website. Paper versions of the survey were available to residents from the Caledon Community Centre.
